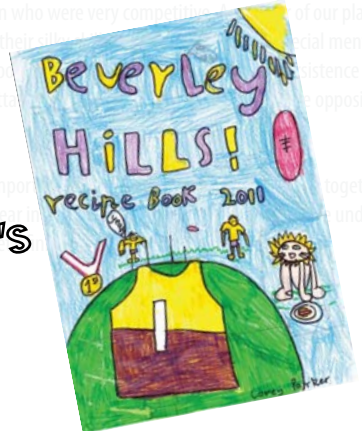

The coach said:

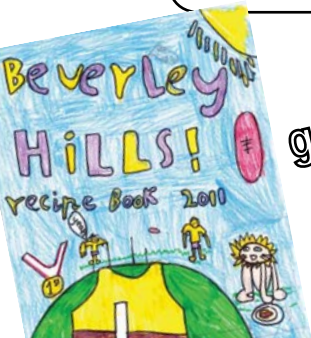

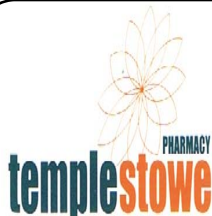
