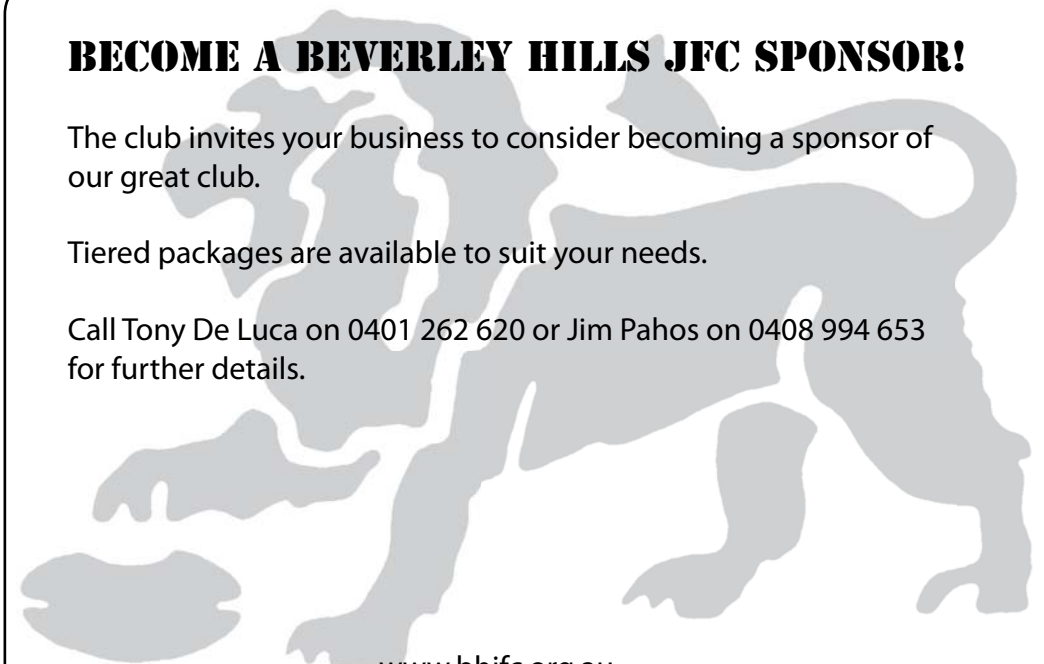

Good team effort but we can improve alot.

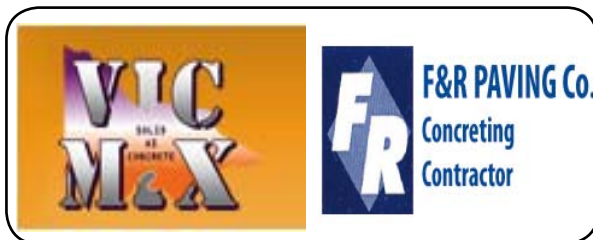
