The Beverley Hill Junior Football Club is displaying commitment to responsible alcohol management with an application for Level Three accreditation under the Australian Drug Foundation's Good Sports program.

Good Sports is the first nationwide alcohol management program of its kind and is supported by VicHealth, the Traffic Accident Commission (TAC), the Department of Health and Department of Health & Ageing. The program was developed following research conducted by the Australian Drug Foundation which indicated that by introducing responsible alcohol management policies, clubs were able to improve membership and enhance viability.

The club is determined to meet the criteria required for the Level Three accreditation.

We now have a written alcohol management policy which includes the sale of low alcohol drinks and soft drinks and a safe transport strategy to ensure our members get home safely. On a cold and windy . . . . . oh who cares what the weather was like! It was all about the football, . . . . . and what a game of football it was!

Our first big test for the season; last year's runner-up; at their home ground. The boys were fired up and determined to get off to a good start. And that they did.
