



Working with Children Legislation

***** AFL Victoria is committed to promoting and protecting the safety and well-being of children and young people in our care.

We seek to promote and protect the rights of all children in our care and prevent abuse from occurring by fostering a child safe culture. All Victorian Leagues, Clubs and Associations that provide football to children and young people will present environments and experiences that always consider and put measures in place to ensure the safety of children *****

Recent Legislation requires that all people in clubs and organisations who come into contact with children under the age of 18 years must undergo a check and be approved to hold his or her position in the organisation.

As all our players are under the age of 18 obviously this legislation greatly affects our club and in fact most sporting clubs throughout the state.

There are a number of exemptions to the requirements, however AFL Victoria is anxious that all volunteers in all applicable football clubs meet the requirements.

Beverley Hills Junior Football Club will ensure that all relevant people meet the requirements.
